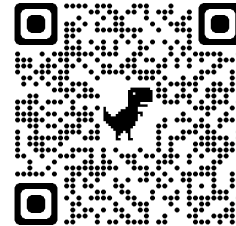

Arizona Public Housing Authority (APHA) – Section 8 – Housing Choice Voucher Waiting List
****OPENING****

The APHA – serving Yavapai County, Arizona will be accepting pre-applications for the Housing Choice Voucher Program from **May 1, 2023 8:00AM (MST) TO May 31, 2023 5:00PM (MST)**.

The APHA will use a lottery system for placement as “Active” on the Waiting List. This means that everyone from first to last that applies has an equal chance at being placed on the list. The total number of applications received during the period that the Waiting List is open will be assessed. **Should the total number of applications per available/anticipated available voucher be greater than 100 to 1, the APHA will use the lottery system for placement as “Active” on the Waiting List. The lottery number will also be applicable for “Selection From” the Waiting List.** For any total number of applications received that is less than 100 to 1, all eligible applications received timely will be placed as “Active” on the Waiting List.

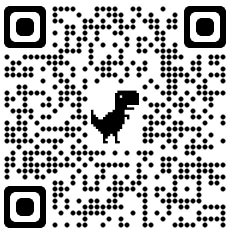
Autoridad de Vivienda Pública de Arizona (APHA) – Sección 8 – Lista de espera de vales de elección de vivienda **APERTURA******

La APHA, que presta servicios en el condado de Yavapai, Arizona, aceptará solicitudes previas para el Programa de vales de elección de vivienda desde el 1 de mayo de 2023 a las 8:00 a.m. (MST) **hasta el 31 de mayo de 2023 a las 5:00 p.m. (MST)**.

La APHA utilizará un sistema de lotería para la colocación como "Activo" en la Lista de Espera. Esto significa que todos, desde el **primero** hasta el **último**, tienen las mismas posibilidades de ser incluidos en la lista. Se evaluará el número total de solicitudes recibidas durante el período de apertura de la Lista de Espera. Si el número total de solicitudes por cupón disponible / anticipado es superior a 100 a 1, la APHA utilizará el sistema de lotería para la colocación como "Activo" en la Lista de Espera. El número de lotería también será aplicable para "Selección de" la Lista de Espera. Para cualquier número total de solicitudes recibidas que sea inferior a 100 a 1, todas las solicitudes elegibles recibidas oportunamente se colocarán como "Activas" en la Lista de Espera.
